Winter Auto Safety Tips

*Slow down in bad weather, and turn your headlights on so other drivers can see you.

*Don't use cruise control on wet, snowy or icy roads.

*Keep entire vehicle clean of ice and snow. Don't forget to brush off the lights (front and back).

*Keep windshield washer reservoir full.

*Keep fuel tank near full in the winter to

prevent fuel line from freezing.

*Keep an emergency kit in vehicle. Suggestions: flashlight, battery powered radio, extra batteries, flares,



bottled water, non-perishable high energy foods, blankets, shovel, first aid kit.



- *For your safety, it is important to change the batteries in your smoke alarms and thermostat.
- *Be careful not to lower your thermostat too low, as frozen pipes can do an incredible amount of damage.
- *Remember to turn off your water and drain the system if you are going to be gone for an extended period.
- *Decks and smaller sheds are very vulnerable to collapse due to snow load.
- *Have an insured contractor remove the snow load from your roof to prevent yourself from injury.
- *If you are burning wood as a heat source make sure you use seasoned wood never use green wood.
- *Salting your walkways and steps will help to prevent someone from slipping on the ice.
